Organic Oaks First Flush



(28.00/53.00/103.00 **O-FF**)

Attractive leaf yields a rich vegetal aroma with delicate notes of citrus and sweet grass. Oaks is one of the oldest plantations in the region

located in Sonada Valley.

Poobong STGBOP1



(13.00/25.00/48.00 **FF**)

Orthodox, cut leaf from the beginning of the picking season, this tea brews a striking cup. Enjoy it after a quick infusion or add it to the other teas to

impart the unique Darjeeling taste.

Mandal Gaon Autumn Oolong



(24.00/45.00/87.00 **NEW**)

This autumn oolong was produced taking cues from Taiwanese manufacturing techniques. The result is a very smooth Darjeeling oolong with a pleasant nutty, toasted character and distinct notes of fruit and chocolate.

Goomtee Spring Oolong

This later season tea has a colourful leaf with lots of tip. It brews an amber cup, highly aromatic and spicy to taste.

Koliapani Autumn Signature Assam



(18.00/34.00/65.00 **NEW**)
This late season, handcrafted black tea has prominent notes of malt, honey and ripe fruits. Goes well with milk if brewed strong!

Namdang BP



(13.00/25.00/48.00)
Quality and appearance make this a good example of an Assam manufactured by the CTC method. It cups well with milk producing an even, strong and deep coloured infusion.

(13.00/25.00/48.00 **SF**)
An old favourite returning to the catalogue. This orthodox, full leaf tea brews an aromatic cup with medium body and full colour.

Parkside FOP



(14.00/27.00/52.00)
Reminiscent of Ceylon tea but with a mellow and generally smoother character. The taste is round and soft, fruity and aromatic; nicely balanced with a hint of earthiness.

Meleng Golden Tips



(21.00/39.00/75.00 **SF**)
The large leaf has abundant golden tip that yields an amber brew with hints of warm, sweet spices and malt.

Nilgiri BOP



(12.00/23.00/44.00)
Tea is grown at high elevation in the Blue Mountains, typically above 5000 feet. These teas are brisk, pungent and full-bodied often compared to those of Ceylon.

Green Tea Powder



(12.00/23.00/44.00/16.00 Tin)

Though perfected by the Japanese over 1000 years ago, green tea powder (matcha) originated by way of Zen Buddhism. Made with the powdered leaves that have undergone minimal oxidation.

Organic Pinhead Gunpowder

Also known as pearl tea, this offering has small tender buds rendering a sweet aroma, an amber liquor and a penetrating flavour.


Elegantly shaped leaves with downy, silver tips and few flowers. The infusion has a wonderful bouquet and delicate flavour.

A classic Chinese green tea where only the new tea buds and the leaf next to the bud are picked. Light and fresh, slightly nutty with a floral sweetness and a pale apricot colour.

A superior Keemun possessing winey, full colour and the characteristic hint of smokiness of a quality Keemun.

Keemun Hao Ya AA



(44.00/85.00/167.00)

Keemun Hao Ya A



(26.00/49.00/95.00)

Possessing a uniform and well-shaped congou leaf, this popular tea retains a full complement of complex flavours and aroma.

Keemun Mao Feng Black

Mutan Silver Tips

White tea with a delicate 'peony' flavour, displaying long silver tips. Unrolled and unfermented, a unique tea.

White Monkey



(21.00/39.00/75.00)

Otherwise known as Baimao Hou, this is a delicate green tea named after the appearance of the leaves which are said to resemble the hands of a white-haired monkey.

Organic Shui Hsien Oolong



(18.00/34.00/65.00)

This traditional oolong has natural orchid-like flavour with a lingering fragrance and possesses a clear, bright, amber colour.

Dà Hóng Páo



(28.00/53.00/103.00)

This legendary tea, a Wuyi Rock Oolong, is offered as a premium grade tea brewing a deep gold/amber cup. The taste is smooth with a fragrant finish.

Goddess of Mercy Premium



(18.00/34.00/65.00)

Brewed in traditional Yixing pots this oolong is fragrant, fruity and delicate. It sports curled leaves and can be infused several times.

Lapsang Souchong Superior Grade



(21.00/39.00/75.00 O)

A high grade, tippy leaf gives this classic smoked tea a more refined and nuanced character.



China Lapsang Souchong



(12.00/23.00/44.00)

Full charcoal smokiness, dark and thick, Lapsang Souchong with a large leaf brews an esoteric cup.

Wild Lapsang Souchong



(18.00/34.00/65.00 O)

From the Wuyi mountains, where the highest trees grow at 2158m, tea plants can be more than 200 years old. It is not smoked but pine tree branches are used to dry the tea, giving the leaves a pine and honey-like flavour.

Lichee Congou



(12.00/23.00/44.00)

A large leaf, black China scented tea with a very characteristic flavour derived from the fruit.

Rose Congou



(12.00/23.00/44.00)

Scented by rose petals to give a fragrant tea with delicate aroma and taste on the palate.

Dan Cong Single Trunk Black



(36.00/69.00/135.00)

A remarkable wild growing tea from the Phoenix Mountains. Brews smooth and sweet with distinct dried fruit notes (think grapefruit and peach).

Yunnan

Ancient Baked Heart Green



(21.00/39.00/75.00 O)

Growing at elevations of 6,000 to 7,200 feet on Wu Liang Mountain; this tea is harvested from ancient tea trees that produce a high quality green tea. The liquor is a light, golden green with medium body, notes of toasted rice and wild flowers.

Ancient Artisan Bi Luo Chun



(32.00/61.00/119.00 O)

Toasted pine nut taste with a light sweet finish. This tea has a heartier, more full body than Bi Luo Chun from other regions.

Snow Dragon 1st Grade



(24.00/45.00/87.00 **NEW-O**)

With snowy white buds curving like a dragon, this delicate hand-rolled green tea brews a refreshing and sweet cup with little astringency.

Golden Snail Special Grade



(41.00/79.00/155.00 **NEW-O**)

These hand-picked, curled buds brew smooth and sweet over many infusions. Mellow roasted aroma with woody/nutty undertones.

Honeyfairlyland Yellow 1st Grade



(24.00/45.00/87.00 **NEW-O**)

This tea has captivating floral top notes mingled with a smooth honeyed body and a subtle creamy, buttery finish.

Black Luo Cha Snail Shape



(21.00/39.00/75.00 **O**)

Tea leaves carefully rolled into the shape of a spiral. The infusion produces an amber-colored liquor that is as smooth as aged Pu-erh tea and has a malty sweet taste and lovely fragrance with a hint of chocolate and flowers.

Mengku Valley Raw Pu Erh



(24.00/45.00/87.00 **O**)

This long and twisted raw pu erh is picked from rare, big leaf trees which grow at a staggering elevation of 7,200 feet on Wuliang Mountain, the youngest being 'only' 150 years old. Bright, golden liquor with notes of tobacco and earthy wildness.

Black Dragon Ball Hong Long Zhu



(28.00/53.00/103.00)

This special tea is completely hand-crafted by rolling the highest quality leaves and buds. When steeped, each ball will slowly unfurl resembling blossoming flowers. The taste is mellow with a touch of earthiness and subtle cocoa notes.

Yunnan Green Pagoda



(21.00/39.00/75.00)

A mild-flavoured artisan tea made with a large leaf variety giving steady fragrance and an elegant after taste.

Golden Yunnan Special Grade



(41.00/79.00/155.00 **NEW-O**)

Full bodied with a smooth finish, rich with complex brown sugar undertones and the aroma of sweet potato and sugarcane.

Yunnan Moonlight White



(21.00/39.00/75.00)

The leaves are taken from trees over 400 years old.... This white tea has long leaves, white on one side and shadowy grey on the other.

Black Needle Cangyuan



(32.00/61.00/119.00 **O**)

This tea in particular has a red apple, cocoa bean aroma and has been hand-roasted in a wok over wood fire in the traditional way. It takes its name from its stunning leaf and its origin on the border of Myanmar. This is a rare organic tea not to be missed!

Yunnan Organic Green



(16.00/30.00/57.00 **O**)

Look at the small needle green leaves of many shades - this is a classic green tea from a province most noted for black. We think you will give it the thumbs up!

Yunnan Organic Black



(14.00/27.00/52.00 **O**)

This large tippy leaf tea brews a full coloured cup. Enjoy its spicy flavour with distinct flowery overtones.

Golden Monkey

(21.00/39.00/75.00)

This striking black tea (resplendent with large golden buds reminiscent of curled monkey paws) is rich, smooth and full bodied with deep earthy notes and an underlying sweetness of cedar and honey thrown in.

Yunnan Mao Jian

(30.00/57.00/111.00 O)

Grown on cloud enveloped hillsides where tea was first cultivated, this black tea has long large golden tips and infuses to give a light, yellow liquor which is refreshing and smooth to the palate.

10 Year Pu Erh

(24.00/45.00/87.00)

Crafted from a big leaf tea of brown or dark red colour which imparts a sweet, mellow flavour and properties associated with longevity.

Pu Erh

(14.00/27.00/52.00)

We stock a matured variety having the full earthy qualities you expect from an aged tea!

Mini Tuo Cha

(12.00/23.00/44.00)

Small individually wrapped cakes of Pu Erh. Just right for a mug of tea, the leaves can be re-infused many times.

Pu Erh Cake

(40.00/350g)

The tea is formed into a flat cake and left to age. It has a smooth body and rich flavour. Break off a small piece and crumble it into your teapot.

Pu Erh Tea Brick

(40.00/350g)

If you like Pu Erh and have not tried a brick tea, this is the one we recommend.

(26.00/49.00/95.00)

A choice grade enjoyed equally by seasoned drinkers and tea explorers. Pale golden infusion with a slightly sweet aftertaste. This tea is produced in Longjing Village near Hangzhou.

Formosa**Green****Formosa Gunpowder**

(12.00/23.00/44.00)

A large Souchong leaf which unfolds giving a pungency and a light straw coloured infusion.

Oolong**Taiwan Oriental Beauty**

(36.00/69.00/135.00)

This oolong has a slightly heavy, slightly sweet cup and possesses a complex and compelling aroma.

Organic Dong Ding Oolong

(24.00/45.00/87.00 O)

The broad leaf has been minimally oxidized with a light to medium roast, giving it a rich taste and fresh aroma with a slightly creamy finish.

Jinxuan Milk Oolong

(21.00/39.00/75.00)

Unique smell and flavour, smooth, creamy, buttery quality with lingering aftertaste.

Superfancy Oolong Silvertip

(21.00/39.00/75.00)

This large leaf, early flush tea has large buds evident in the infusion. Graded as Silvertip, this tea has most superior characteristics.

Bamboo Mountain Dong Ding



(18.00/34.00/65.00)

Grown at lower elevation, at about 800m, this offering received a lighter roasting resulting in a bright yellow cup.

Four Seasons Jasmine Oolong

Known as Si Ji Chun, the Four Seasons Spring tea bush cultivar, this oolong thrives at middle elevations in Taiwan's central highlands.

Organic GABA Oolong



(21.00/39.00/75.00 O)

Organic GABA oolong is a light and refreshing tea with crisp fruit flavours and a hint of bubbly creaminess. Its unusual method of processing involves exposure to a nitrogen rich environment.

Formosa Oolong



(12.00/23.00/44.00)

With classic nutty, peachy flavour, light body, very aromatic and devoid of astringency, this is a perfect refreshment for any time of day.



Ginseng Oolong

Picked from wild trees, this Shan Cha (mountain) tea has a distinctive, pleasant honey aroma. Very smooth with a light, refreshing tartness. The pleasant taste is well rounded with evocations of pastries and baked sweets with fruit notes similar to Japanese white peaches.

This hand-made rarity has long pine needle-shaped, dark green leaves and infuses a clear light yellow with fresh grass scent and a highly aromatic taste. Reinfuses many times.


